WARDEN'S REPORT FOR 1953

To the members of St. John's Church, West Toronto.

We take pleasure in submitting the financial statement for the year 1953, and wish to express our sincere thanks to all those who through their offerings have made this report possible.

Total contributions for the year for all purposes amounted to \$31,233.56 including a bequest of \$1,220.00 All current expenses have been met and our missionary allotment of \$4,650.00 paid in full. We have also contributed the sum of \$1,635.65 for objects outside our own parish in addition to disbursing the balances held for the Nichols' Scholarship fund and the Diocesan Extension Fund held at January 1, 1953. The indebtedness of \$2,800.00 to the Canadian Bank of Commerce as at January 1, 1953 was repaid in full in June.

As at the end of the year we had expended on renovation and maintenance account \$14,498.33. This amount includes renovations to the Church and rectory and other work connected therewith. We have borrowed from the bank the sum of \$18,000.00 to meet accounts which were not received prior to December 31st.

Fire Insurance on the Church, Organ and Movable contents has been increased to \$190,000.00 and on the rectory to \$13,000.00.

We again express our appreciation to our Ladies' organizations, the Women's Auxiliary, and the Evening Branch of the same for their great contributions to the Domestic and Foreign Mission work of the church, and to the Women's Guild for their fine assistance in enabling us to carry out our plans.

May we voice our sincere thanks to the Rector and his associates for their splendid leadership, their spiritual guidance and great co-operation in carrying on the work of the church. We also wish to express our sincere thanks to all organizations of the church for their loyalty and co-operation.
