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## ST. JOHN'S SEDER EUCHARIST

THE SEDER IS A RITUAL MEAL ORIGINALLY EATEN BY THE JEWISH PEOPLE ON PASSOVER NIGHT TO COMMEMORATE GOD'S DELIVERING—THEM OUT OF EGYPT. FOR CHRISTIANS, IT IS IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER THAT IT WAS THE JEWISH SEDER MEAL WHICH BECAME THE LAST SUPPER, THE FIRST EUCHARIST. ON HOLY THURSDAY, ST. JOHN'S WILL COMBINE BOTH JEWISH AND CHRISTIAN TRADITIONS. OUR TARISHIONERS WILL FIRST SHARE A SEDER MEAL INCLUDING THE RITUAL MATZOH (UNLEAVENED BREAD) AND WINE, PARTAKE OF HOLY COMMUNION AND THEN, WITH LIGHTED TAPERS, PROCESS INTO THE DARKENED CHURCH.

THE ALTAR WILL BE STRIPPED, PRAYERS SAID
AND ALL WILL DEPART IN SILENCE. THE
SEDER SUPPER HAS BECOME A TRADITION AT
ST. JOHN'S SINCE IT WAS INTRODUCED TO THE
PARISH BY MRS. MAY WEBSTER AND MR. GARY
GRAY, ORGANIST. IT HAS PROVEN TO BE A
MOVING AND SIGNIFICANT PREPARATION FOR
GOOD FRIDAY. THIS YEAR'S SEDER SUPPER
WILL TAKE PLACE ON THURSDAY, MARCH 31,
AT 6:30 P.M. IN THE PARISH HALL.
