Joseph Waterhouse Rutty became a planter, working at Trelawny, and then St. Thomas. While at Duckenfield, he joined the Jamaica Volunteers, which were called out to quell the riot in Morant Bay in 1865. He was found the next day, barely alive, with his left hand smashed, his jawbone broken, a cutlass wound across the back of his neck, and twenty-two other cuts on his head.

After recovering in Morant Bay Hospital, he went to Arthur's Seat in Manchester to stay with his sister, Mary Windsor MacDermot and family. He went from there to Trelawny, where he was employed by Henry Sewell, the largest land-owner in the parish. He worked as Overseer for Home Castle, Dornock, and Dover properties, at that time the best cattle properties on the island - 4000 acres of grass and commons. There were very fine stables built at Home Castle, with two stallions, and three jacks (jackasses). Joseph reared some of the finest horses and mules on the island. Quite a few of his colts were sold to officers at the Army Camp in Kingston, and won a good many races.

On a weekend visit to another Sewell estate, Lottery, where his brother William Henry Rutty was Overseer, he met Mrs. Elizabeth Page, the last child of the Roger Swires, and the widow of Henry Constine Page (son of Colonel Page of St. Thomas). They became engaged and were married in the Falmouth Parish Church. They lived at Home Castle, with the two children of her first marriage: Robert Andrew Page and Henrietta Constance Page. They had six children of their own, as listed.

Frances Lydia Cox's father was the colonel of an English regiment. The future Lord Clive was a penniless lieutenant in his regiment. Clive fell in love with Frances, but the colonel said no go and packed her off to the island of St. Vincent, where his sister lived, the wife of the Bishop of St. Vincent. There she met a Yorkshireman by the name of Roger Swire, who had inherited property on the island, and they fell in love. Roger chartered a schooner and eloped with her to Antigua, where they married. They then returned to St. Vincent. The eruption of local volcano Soufriere so damaged his properties that they migrated (with their now large family) to Jamaica, and purchased two sugar estates and one coffee plantation. Their youngest daughter, Elizabeth, married Harry Page, who died of yellow fever. He died shortly before their second child was born. The widow Page then married Joseph Waterhouse Rutty.

Brief History of the Wynne Family: copied from "Guide to Plas Mawr, Conway, (Wales), by the late J.R. Furness, Curator of the Royal Cambrian Academy of Art, from January 9th, 1887, to June 30th, 1920 - revised by C.G. Dyall, Curator, pub. 1923.

The Wynne Family:

The following particulars relating to the family and crests of Plas Mawr have been taken from the writings of Sir John Wynne, Bart., the historian - also from the work on Plas Mawr by Messrs. Arthur and Herbert Baker, and from other sources. Brevity in these particulars has been considered, as more lengthy information can readily be obtained from the various pedigrees, etc.

Plas Mawr, Conway, was built by Robert Wynne, who was born in 1520. He was the third son of John Wynne, of Gwydir, near Llanrwst. The ancestry of Robert Wynne may be traced from Caractacus through the line of British Kings to Gruffydd ap Cynan, the last to hold

the title of "King of Wales", whose son Owain Gwynedd, Prince of Wales, who died 1169, bore "vert three Eaglets displayed in fesse or". Of Owain Gwynedd's sons, Roderic was the ancestor of Robert Wynne. Iorwerth was the father of Llewelyn the Great, and ancestor through the female line of the Royal Family of Tudor; and David, who became Prince of Wales, married th sister of Henry II, and was slain at Conway with all the family by Llewelyn the Great.

The Gwydir estate came into the possession of the Wynne family through purchase from David ap Howel Coetmore, a descendant of Iorwerth ap Owain Gwynedd, by Meredith Wynne, who died 1483, and was succeeded by his son, John Wynne. His eldest son, Morrys, inherited Gwydir, and he was the father of Sir John Wynne, the historian, and ancestor of the Wynnes of Wynnstay. The third son, Robert, became possessed of land in the town of Conway, upon which he built Plas Mawr, about 1576-80. The property remained in the family until late in the seventeenth century, when it passed by marriage into the Mostyn family, who are the present owners, and from whom it is held by the Royal Cambrian Academy of Art.

Gwilim, who married Janet, daughter of Sir Wm. Stanley, of Hooton, was made Hereditary Chamberlain of North Wales, and Grand Forrester of Snowdon by Henry VI, but his son William was only allowed to assume office on condition that he married an Englishwoman; he, therefore, espoused Alice, daughter of Sir Richard Dalton, who shield was a "Lion Rampant". His grandson, Sir William Griffith, of Penrhyn, Knight Chamberlain of North Wales, married Jane, daughter of Sir Thos. Stradling, of St. Donat's Castle, Glamorganshire, by whom he had a numerous family. His daughter, Dorothy, married first William Williams, of Cochwillan, and, secondly, Robert Wynne, of Plas Mawr, Conway. She died without issue in 1586.
