

## 3 DEATHS FROM "FLU," 70 NEW CASES REPORTED

Soldier and 2 Civilians Succumb

—City's Total Reaches

727

Three additional deaths from Spanish influenza and 70 new cases of the disease were reported to the health authorities in the 24-hour period ended at 3 o'clock this afternoon.

Miss Teresa McGregor, 74 Isabel st., T. L. Robinson, of Chicago, and Pte. James Foster Haslett, were the victims.

Since the disease first appeared 643 civilian cases and 86 cases among soldiers, making a total of 727, were recorded, from which 22 deaths resulted. Of the deaths, 15 were among civilians and seven among soldiers.

According to the records, 202 patients have recovered and have been released, leaving 441 person afflicted.

Taking every phase of the situation into account the health department claims it is satisfied with the results. The death rate remains stationary at about 2.5 per cent. and the new cases are in localities where former cases developed.

Vaccine has been placed in the hands of physicians from a central laboratory in the medical college. Citizens are urged to go to their doctors and become inoculated. It is expected that thousands will be vaccinated.
